1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider and decide the premature release of the petitioner in the light of the Punjab Govt. Premature Release Policy dated 08.08.2011 (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned State counsel today supplied a photocopy of order dated 06.09.2024 passed by learned CJM, Ludhiana and submits that petitioner has been granted the relief of interim bail till the final decision is taken by the competent authority regarding premature release of the petitioner. He further submits that the case of the petitioner would be considered within two months from today.
3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide the premature case of the present petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
