1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.84 dated 10.06.2023 under Sections 307/148/149 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 24.06.2023.

2. Learned State counsel, at the outset, has opposed the prayer made for quashing of the FIR in question, as the petitioners are habitual offenders as there are many criminal cases registered against them, which stands reflected in the short reply filed by the State on the last date of hearing.

3. In the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioners has made a prayer for withdrawal of the instant petition.
