Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Dr. Ashish Tyagi, Deputy Director, General Medical Education and Research, who is present in person, submits that the claim of the petitioner towards interest on the delayed disbursement of financial benefits has been forwarded to the Finance Department and the needful with respect to the release thereof shall be done within a period of 04 weeks from today.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
