1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 24.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) whereby he was transferred from Jalandhar to Rajasthan.

2. Ms. Anita Balyan, Senior Panel Counsel submits that petitioner under the protection of interim order of this Court has completed his 3 years normal period of stay, thus, his case needs to be reconsidered in the light of existing transfer policy as well as any other factor relating to him.

3. Mr. A.P.S. Rehan, Advocate submits that apart from policy, respondents may be directed to consider the fact that he is facing matrimonial cases which are pending in District Courts, Ambala and Pathankot.
