The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to issue appointment letter to the petitioner with retrospective benefit and pecuniary losses for the post of HOD in view of advertisement dated 02.07.2015 (Annexure P-5). Further seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the appointment letter dated 07.12.2015 (Annexure P-9) issued to respondent No.3.

The petitioner has also filed an application bearing CM No.15368-CWP-2024 under Section 151 of CPC for placing on record certain documents and CM No.15369-CWP-2024 under Order 1 Rule 10 of CPC read with Section 151 of CPC for impleading the Secretary, Society of Institute of Hotel Management Catering Technology &



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Applied Nutrition-cum-Principal, IHM, Bathinda as necessary party in the petition.

After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition and also CM Nos.15368 &15369-CWP-2024 with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better particulars, in accordance with law.
