Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted the Double Special Pay from 01.01.2016, which is required to be taken into account for fixing the pensionary benefits of the petitioner, hence, the respondents be directed to release pensionary benefits along with the arrears.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the reply has been given to the petitioner on 19.06.2024 but the same is not deciding the claim of the petitioner and rather the issue has been kept pending in an arbitrary manner and therefore, the respondents be directed to decide the legal notice on merits by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. T.P.S Chawla, Sr. D.A.G. Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the legal notice (Annexure P-5) dated 16.05.2024 has been received in the concerned office, an appropriate order on the same would be passed by respondent No.2 within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of copy of this order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
