Prayer in the application is for impleadment of the LRs of petitioner (deceased-Sher Singh) in the main petition.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions and only for the purpose of pursuing this petition only. Amended Memo of Parties is taken on record.

Registry is directed to do the needful.

**Main case:**

Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to change the place of plot claimed to have been allotted to the petitioner under the welfare scheme of the Government from village pond to some other suitable place.

In the written statement filed by the respondent State, a specific stand has been taken that a wrong fact has been put up before this Court by the petitioner about his father having moved an application on 24.08.1996

for change of plot from village pond to some other suitable place whereas the said application was moved by one Sh. Het Ram son of Sh. Kashi Ram whereas the name of petitioner’s father is Sh. Leelu Ram son of Sh. Dhari Ram. Hence, there are disputed questions of fact involved as also with regards to the entity and entitlement of the petitioner to establish an allotment in its favour. Even though the said written statement has been filed by the respondent-State on 08.11.2018, however, no replication to the same has been filed and hence, the facts averred therein stands uncontroverted.

Involving disputed questions of fact, which such issues cannot be gone into by this Court, the present petition is **disposed of** with liberty to the petitioner to take appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
