1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 12 and 2A of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 or the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful non-compliance of the Order dated 28.04.2023 passed by this Court in LPA-491-2023.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that the order dated 31.07.2023 (Annexure R-1) appended along with the affidavit dated 08.11.2023 already stands withdrawn.
