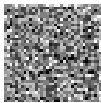

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the authorities concerned so as to prove that he has done no wrong for which he should be suspended, hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the higher authorities for the redressal of his grievance.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ranjit Singh Kalra, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioner raises any grievance before the higher concerned authorities by



filing representation, the same will be looked into and an appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of six weeks of the receipt of the same and in case, it is found feasible to grant the benefit as being claimed, the same will be granted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner and the said speaking order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
