1. The challenge in the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is to the advertisement dated 17.07.2020 whereby 03 posts of Superintending Engineers in the respondent-Board were advertised on contractual basis for a period of 01 year extendable upto 03 years or 65 years of age, whichever is earlier.
2. While issuing notice of motion on 02.11.2020, it was ordered that advertisement dated 17.07.2020 shall not be given effect to.
3. Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.2 has already been promoted on regular basis as Superintending Engineer during the pendency of the present petition

and since the period mentioned in the advertisement has already been elapsed, therefore, the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
