The instant third petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.33 dated 06.04.2024, under Sections 458, 324, 323, 148, 149 and 506 of the IPC, 1860 (Sections 326, 325, 459 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties and hence, he prays to withdraw the instant petition.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3/complainant is also present in Court and states that he is not pressing on the investigating officer to proceed with the investigation in this FIR since the matter already stands compromised.

Prayer is accepted.
Dismissed as withdrawn.
