1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the pending dues/arrears of pay and increment as per the seniority of the petitioner and to release the salary as per new pay scales started in the year 2006 and to release the full pay and dues of suspension period from 23.10.2008 to 16.09.2010 and also to promote the petitioner to the post of Junior Engineer from the date his juniors were promoted. Further, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 18.02.2015 (Annexure P-8), passed by respondent No.2, whereby the suspension period of the petitioner was treated as a leave period.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 22.07.2024, the following order was passed :-

issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to release the pending dues/arrears of pay and increment as per the seniority of the petitioner and to release the salary as per new scales started in the year 2006 and to release the full pay and dues of suspension period from 23.10.2008 to 16.09.2010 by treating the said period as leave of kind due and also to promote the petitioner to the post of Junior Engineer from the date his juniors were promoted.

An adjournment is being sought by the learned counsel for the petitioner time and again. Today again, he has not put in appearance. However, Mr. Amandeep Singh Dandiwal, Advocate has put in appearance on his behalf as proxy counsel and again seeks an adjournment.

Prayer is accepted, subject to the payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association Welfare Fund.

Adjourned to 02.12.2024.”

3. The cost has not been deposited.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions from the petitioner.
5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-proseuction.
