SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, but he prays that directions be passed upon the Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum- Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Pehowa, to within a period of two months from today, decide the appeal raised by respondents No. 6 & 7 to the demarcation report, wherein, they were declared to be making encroachment upon the Panchayat land. Ordered accordingly.

2. In case, any decision against the present petitioners is made on the said appeal by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum- Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Pehowa, then it is open to the present petitioners to make an

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appeal thereagainst before the further revisional /Appellate Authority concerned. A clear mandamus is also passed upon the appellate authority / revisional authority concerned, to within six months, from the passing of the decision on the appeal (supra) preferred by respondents No. 6 & 7 against the demarcation report, to thus decide the said appeal /revision. Moreover, in case, the respondents (supra) are conclusively declared to be encroaching upon the Panchayat land, thereupon at that stage, it is open to the petitioners to move an application qua the said respondents becoming removed from the respectively held posts by them of Panches of the respective Wards. The said motions /applications be also decided within three months.

3. Consequently, the extant petition is dismissed as withdrawn but with the aforesaid directions.
