The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.16 dated 17.03.2023 under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC read with Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (regulations) Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.12.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 20.12.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.12.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
