1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No. 4 and 5 (XEN and SDO, Department of Soil and Water Conservation, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, respectively) to include the land of the petitioners for laying down of underground pipeline in Mogha Burji No. 109709/R, from which the petitioners are irrigating their respective land.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner, at the outset, submits that as regards claim in the instate civil writ petition, the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 28.05.2024 (Annexure P-8) upon official respondents and the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions be issued to respondent No. 4 (XEN) to consider and decide the legal notice (Annexure P-8), served by the petitioners, in a time bound manner.

3. Learned State counsel appears in pursuance to advance copy of writ petition have been served upon him and submits that in case, any such legal notice is received in the office of respondent No. 4, the same shall be considered and decided, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, within a

period of one month from the date of receipt/production of certified copy of this order.

4. In view of submission made by learned State counsel, the instant civil writ petition is disposed of.
5. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stands closed.
