1. By this common order CWP-18913-2022 and CWP-12790-2022 are disposed of since issues involved in the above captioned petitions and prayer sought are common. With the consent of parties and for the sake of brevity, facts are borrowed from CWP-18913-2022.



2. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting of order dated 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-5) whereby Controlling Authority under Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 (for short ‘1972 Act’) and order dated 25.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) whereby Appellate Authority have directed the petitioner to pay gratuity alongwith interest.
3. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that all the departmental proceedings stand concluded, thus, the petitioner should implement order passed by Appellate Authority under 1972 Act subject to liability determined by Disciplinary Authority while passing order of punishment.
4. In the wake of statement of both side, the present petitions stand disposed of.
5. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
