1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the services of the petitioner have already been regularized vide order dated 27.12.2021 but, the claim of the petitioner with regard to grant of the minimum of the pay scale in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **State of Punjab and others Vs. Jagjit Singh and others, 2016 (4) S.C.T 641** has not been decided which is causing prejudice as, the petitioner was entitled for the minimum of the pay scale for the post of Assistant Librarian as being granted to the other regular employees.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received at the hands of the petitioner, the same will be examined by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation/claim by passing an appropriate



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speaking order and in case, it is found that the petitioner was entitled for the benefit of minimum of the pay scale alongwith DA while working on the post of Assistant Librarian, the same will be given, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file appropriate representation with the respondents.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
