1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 10.04.2023 passed in CWP-580-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Radhika Singh, HCS, Joint Secretary, Finance Department, Haryana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 10.04.2023 passed in CWP-580-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 07.11.2023 (Annexure R-2) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
