NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the impugned order dated 14.10.2020 endorsed on 16.10.2020 (Annexure P-7), vide which respondent No.3 has been given the current duty charge of the post of Executive Engineer (Civil) and further seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to give current duty charge of the post of Executive Engineer (Civil) to the petitioners, who have not been promoted on the basis of seniority-cum-merit and in accordance with the statutory rules.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioners have been regularly promoted to the post of Executive Engineer (Civil) on 23.08.2022 and even respondent No.3 has also been regularly promoted to the post of



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Executive Engineer (Civil) w.e.f. 16.08.2024, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
