Application for exemption is allowed as prayed for.

Main petition

1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.117 dated 30.05.2024 under Sections 406 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Sector-17, Faridabad, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1).
2. Report from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received wherein it is stated that the parties have settled the matter by way of settlement/agreement dated 30.08.2024. The same has already been placed on record.
3. Learned counsel for the complainant affirms the factum of the compromise.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the compromise a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- has been paid to the respondent through RTGS and remaining amount would be paid by the petitioner to the respondent on or before 04.11.2024.

5. Since the matter has already been settled between the parties, so the present petition is allowed and petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to the condition mentioned in Section 438(2) Cr.PC with further condition that petitioner would comply with the terms of the settlement in its letter & spirit. In case of any default, this order shall automatically stand vacated.

6. Petitioner is directed to join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
