1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and take action on their representation dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that they are major. They are in love. Petitioner No.1 has started living with petitioner No.2. Respondents No.4 to 6 are residing nearby and are having bad eye on petitioner No.1. Apprehending danger to their lives and liberty, they sent representation dated 08.07.2024 to the respondent No.2 but the same has not been taken into consideration and hence, the present petition.

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4. Mr. Arjun Lakhanpal, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage. The petitioners' counsel is directed to supply the copy of the petition to him.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the veracity of the averments made in the petition and also with regard to the sanctity of relationship or age of the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-the Superintendent of Police, Gurgaon to look into the matter and dispose of the representation dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law and also to take necessary step, if any, genuine threat to life and liberty of the petitioners is found.
6. A copy of this order along with copy of representation dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2, so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
7. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
