Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing respondents to grant the benefits of past service rendered by the petitioner till date and for further directing the respondents to allow him for appearing in B-1 test, under 62% category as per Rule 13.7 (1) (a) of the Punjab Police Rules, 2017 going to be held in first/second week of July, 2024.

(2) Learned State counsel has produced copy of an order dated 28.11.2024 passed by Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Home and Jails Department, which is taken on record as mark 'X' (colly). Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.
