AMAN CHAUDHARY. J. (ORAL)

1. The present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularise the services of the petitioners from the due dates as P.R. Chowkidars.
2. Learned counsel submits that during the pendency of this petition, though all the petitioners have been granted regularisation, however, petitioner Nos.1 to 4 with effect from 1992, while their claim was from 1989, with regard to which, they will file a representation within a period of 4 weeks, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.
3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.
4. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction that in case petitioners submit a representation within a period of 4 weeks, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents within a period of 6 months and if found entitled,

necessary benefits be granted to the petitioners forthwith. However, in the eventuality of the relief being denied, a speaking order be passed, after associating them therewith.
