1. On 12.07.2024, the following order was passed:-

“The applicant-wife has filed the present application for seeking transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, filed at the instance of the respondent-husband, which is pending in Family Court Ludhiana, to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Ambala.

It is submitted by learned counsel that two daughters born from the wedlock of the parties to the lis, who are aged 8 years and 4 years, are in the custody of the applicant-wife. As such, it is difficult for the applicant to pursue the litigation, filed at the instance of the respondent-husband from Ambala, which is at a distance of about 100 kilometers from Ludhiana. Moreover, the proceedings qua FIR, filed at the instance of the applicant, are pending in Ambala Cantt. and the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is also pending in Ambala.

Notice of motion for 28.08.2024.

Notice re: stay as well.

Learned Trial Court shall adjourn the case, beyond the date fixed by this Court.”

2. As per office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

3. For the reasons, noted in the order dated 12.07.2024, the application is

allowed.

4. The petition HMA/1697/2023 dated 10.07.2023 titled as “Pardeep Kumar Vs. Pooja” presently pending in the Court of Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana is transferred to the Court of Competent Jurisdiction at Ambala.

5. The Transferor Court is directed to remit the file to the transferee Court forthwith, after informing learned counsel representing the respondent for appearing before the transferee Court on 04.10.2024.
