By way of present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 31.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from SI Yashpal has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor she is required for



further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 31.07.2024, the following order was passed:-

“ 1.Status report dated 30.07.2024 filed in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ, Nuh, District Nuh is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

2.A query was raised by the Court to ASI Mukesh Kumar, Investigating Officer of the case present in Court, to show any record regarding withdrawal of the amount, upon which he has sought some time to produce the complete record.

3.List on 21.08.2024.

4.In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, she shall be released on interim bail on her furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 31.07.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 31.07.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of



written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; she will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
