Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the claim of the respondents not to consider certain documents on the ground that the same were not countersigned by the authorities of the Education Department has already been decided by this Court while passing order in LPA No. 1413 of 2023 titled as ***Jyotsna Bhasker Vs. State of Punjab***, dated 26.07.2024 and the respondents are liable to be directed to consider the claim of the petitioners in terms of the said judgment by passing appropriate orders.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate order will be passed considering the claim of the petitioners in light of the judgment in ***Jyotsna Bhasker's case (supra)*** and in case, it is found feasible to grant the benefits to the petitioners, the same will be granted, otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners,



which order will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
