1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3 who is threatening the petitioner of false implication at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and to take action on their representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) as well as reminder letter dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-4).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner have filed a representation on 03.10.2023 before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar (**Annexure P-3**) and thereafter vide reminder letter dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same have not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to



respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) as well as reminder letter dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat perception is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.
