Prayer in the present petition is for issuing direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner at the hands of the respondents No.4 & 5, who are threatening the petitioner of false implication in some false criminal case as the respondent No.5 enjoys political mileage and inspite of the fact that two enquiries have been done and the allegations levelled by respondents No.4 & 5 were found false, still an enquiry has been again initiated by respondent No.3 at the instance of respondents No.4 and 5 even when respondent No.3 has no jurisdiction to look into the said complaint. Further prayer has been made for staying the enquiry being held by respondent No.3 as the said enquiry is without jurisdiction and being done when two enquires have already been done by senior police officers of Jalandhar Commissionerate and Amritsar Commissionerate.

After hearing the counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation for redressal of his grievance before respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran within a week from today. If he files any such representation, then respondent No.2 is directed to look into it and decide the same as per law within four weeks from the date of its filing.
