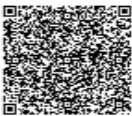

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.68 dated 12.05.2024, registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even though the petitioner has been named in the FIR yet there is no specific attribution to him. He further contends that the injured/complainant had suffered five injuries on his person, which are attributed to the co-accused. Learned counsel further contends that his co-accused Nirbhai Singh alias Gaggi was arrested, however, vide order dated 04.07.2024 (Annexure P-2), he was granted the concession of bail by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur. Apart from that, Khushpreet Singh alias Khushi alias Ghoni, Harry Khan, Kakdi Singh and



Jashandeep Singh have also been granted the concession of bail by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court. However, he admits that no specific injury has been attributed to the present petitioner. He further submits that medical opinion has been received and as per that, one injury has been declared to be grievous in nature.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. From the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that no specific injury has been attributed to the present petitioner. Even further, co-accused, namely, Nirbhai Singh alias Gaggi, Khushpreet Singh alias Khushi alias Ghoni, Harry Khan, Kakdi Singh and Jashandeep Singh have already been admitted to bail by the trial Court.

6. Thus, without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. It will be open for the Investigating Officer to call the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing a written notice in this regard and he shall abide by the conditions mentioned in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
