Prayer in the present writ petition was for seeking directions to the respondents not to displace the petitioners and other families from the colony situated at Brahman Majra, Sirhind, till the time of their rehabilitation as per Housing for All Scheme under In Situ Slum Rehabilitation (ISSR) Vertical of PSAY Scheme.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that they have made repeated attempts to contact the petitioners for further instructions, however, the petitioners are no more responding to his requests.

It is also seen that the matter pertains to the year 2018 and is being repeatedly adjourned. So much so, that there was no representation on

behalf of the petitioners on the last three occasions and the interim order dated 26.07.2018 was also vacated as a mark of caution vide order dated 20.09.2023. Despite the same, the petitioners have chosen not to contact their counsel. It seems that the petitioners are no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
