The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of the order dated 04.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram and order dated 09.10.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Ld. JMIC, Gurugram in complaint No.NACT/39420/2021 Dated 18.11.2021 titled as Hanish Chug Versus Rahul International u/s 138, 141, 142 of the N.I. Act 1881 vide which the application under Section 143A of the Negotiable Instruments Act 1881 has been allowed wrongly and illegally directing the petitioner to deposit 20% of the cheque amount.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that since the impugned complaint itself is at final stages and is fixed for 04.10.2024, therefore, he has no objection if this petition is allowed and the petitioner does not pay 20% of the cheque amount by way of interim compensation as directed to be paid vide order dated 04.06.2024 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram.



3. In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The impugned order dated 04.06.2024 is set aside to the extent to which direction was given to the petitioner to pay 20% of the cheque amount as interim compensation.

4. A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court.
