1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing sale notice dated 16.06.2022 (Annexure P-4) issued by respondent-Bank and order dated 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by District Magistrate, Gurdaspur regarding taking over possession of property in question. There is further prayer to regularize loan account of petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for respondents-Bank on instructions from Mr. Sanjay Kumar, Branch Head, Union Bank of India, Batala submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioner's loan account has been regularized.

3. There is no representation on behalf of petitioner. Even on the last two occasions when this writ petition was taken up for hearing, none had appeared on behalf of petitioner.

4. Be that as it may, in view of the categorical statement made by learned counsel for respondents-Bank, we find no ground for continuation of present proceedings.

5. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. In case, any incorrect fact has been placed before us, petitioner is at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
