1. The instant first petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.329 dated 12.07.2021, under Sections 323, 342, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa (Annexure P-5).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the matter has already been compromised between the parties and even the decree of divorce has been passed, as such, the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Chief Judicial Magistrate for withdrawal of the FDR for Rs.5 lakhs, which was deposited in terms of the order dated 07.02.2023 as a security towards gold ornaments whereas the petitioner had already paid a sum of Rs.28,00,000/- as full and final settlement towards maintenance.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Om Pati, has verified that the cancellation report has already been prepared in terms of the compromise effected between the parties.
4. In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
