DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

1. Status report dated 07.11.2024 filed by the State in Court today is ordered to be taken on record.
2. The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0283 dated 10.11.2020 registered under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.6, (Police Commissionerate Ludhiana), District Ludhiana.
3. On 06.09.2024, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the matter between the petitioner and the complainant stands compromised which fact is admitted by learned counsel appearing for the complainant.

Adjourned to 08.11.2024.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of her arrest in FIR No.0283 dated 10.11.2020 registered under Sections 409,



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420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.6, (Police Commissionerate Ludhiana), District Ludhiana, she shall be released on *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

On the adjourned date, the State shall apprise this Court with regard to the status of the disciplinary proceedings initiated against ASI Amrik Singh (Retd.).”

4. Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and that her custodial interrogation is not required by the State.
5. After considering the afore statement made on behalf of the State and because the matter between the petitioner and respondent No.2 stands compromised, subject to the petitioner's abiding by the conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., the order of this Court dated 06.09.2024, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
6. The matter be put up on 17.01.2025 for the State to file a fresh status report with regard to the status of the disciplinary proceedings already initiated against ASI Amrik Singh (Retd.)
