Prayer made in the present writ petition is for seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to ensure that the petitioner is not implicated in a false criminal case on the basis whereof a fresh complaint No.588-PC-R/DSP (R) FZR moved by respondent No. 6 to respondent No.3 as an earlier complaint No. 3904-PC dated 07.10.2019 filed by respondent No.6 was inquired into by the Incharge E.O Wing, Ferozepur vide enquiry report dated 20.07.2020 and the said complaint had been filed vide letter dated 11.08.2020.

A short reply has been filed by Sandeep Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ferozepur on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 today in the Court. The above said factual aspects have not been disputed as regards conducting of an earlier

enquiry. It has been contended that the subsequent complaint moved by the respondent No.6 has been looked into and the same has been filed in view of the Office Order No. 137-223/PA/DGP dated 01.04.2008 as no second inquiry on the same allegation is admissible. The same has thus been filed. The grievance of the petitioner thus stands redressed.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival if the aforesaid information and facts are found to be incorrect.
