Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the orders dated 23.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.8 granting the stage carriage permits on the inter-state route Daulatpur-Amritsar without any authority or jurisdiction and in violation of the Punjab Transport Scheme, 2018 and also the undated order (Annexure P-4) substantively reviewing the earlier order to convert the grant of permits to a different route Talwara-Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-State has submitted that the permit in question has already been cancelled.
