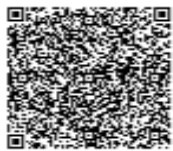

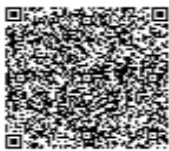

PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0007 dated 25.01.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 177, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar.
2. On oral request made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is treated as petition under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
3. Petitioner is accused of being witness to the bond furnished by fake surety.
4. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind bars for more than 01 year, 05 months and 20 days. Co-accused, namely, Sharanjit Singh already stands admitted to bail.

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5. It is a magisterial trial. This Court vide order dated 10.05.2024 passed in CRM-M-49429-2023 dealt with bunch of these cases relating to furnish of fake sureties and granted them bail.
6. Keeping in view the incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
7. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
