On the last date of hearing, following order was passed by this

Court:-

Learned counsel for the respondent-State is directed to place on record the order fixing the salary of the petitioner upon retrospective promotion though notionally so that the petitioner could be satisfied that the benefit admissible to him have already been extended.

Adjourned to 23.12.2024

It is made clear that in case so such order is placed on record, respondent No.2 shall remain present in the Court to explain the delay.”

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the salary of the petitioner has notionally been fixed and thereafter, even the benefits admissible to the petitioner have also been granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the passing of such kind of order.

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Today, learned counsel for the respondent-State has shown order dated 18.12.2024 alongwith the revision of the salary of the petitioner.

Prima facie, the relief as being claimed by the petitioner has already been granted to the petitioner and in case, any relief for which the petitioner was entitled for, has not been extended to him, petitioner can make appropriate representation to the respondent raising the said grievance and in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the same within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of said representation and in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be granted to the petitioner otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
