1. By way of present second petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, pending trial in case FIR No.140 dated 27.11.2012, registered under Sections 307, 148, 149, 120-B IPC (Section 302 IPC added later on), at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition on merits, however, he refers to medical status report dated 27.01.2024 filed at the instance of the Superintendent Central Jail, Kapurthala, which contains report dated 27.01.2024 by the Medical Officer, Central Jail, Kapurthala, as per which, the petitioner being known case of upper and lower limb paralysis, requires continues care of a nurse for his daily pursuits.

3. Considering the aforesaid, the Chief Medical Officer, Government Hospital, Kapurthala, is requested to medically examined the petitioner and upon his assessment, if need be, petitioner be provided all possible medical assistance/help including any requirement of he being admitted to the Government Hospital, Kapurthala, as per his wisdom.
4. It is made clear that this order may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
5. The present petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
