1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 12.12.2023 passed in CWP-23986-2022.

3. Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and Mr. Ranjit Singh Kalra, Advocate and Mr. Birinder Pal, Advocate, accept notice on behalf of respondent No.3.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents-State has produced copy of letter/order dated 15.07.2024, vide which, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected. Copy of said letter/order is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if it feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondents.
