The petitioner has filed the criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, as the police authorities had allegedly falsely implicated the present petitioner in different FIR.

Learned State counsel submits that 05 different FIRs were ordered to be registered against the present petitioner and the details of the said FIRs are as follows:-

- “(a) FIR No. 239 dated 02.08.2014 Under Section 21 NDPS Act.
(Date of Arrest 02.08.2014),
Present Status: Petitioner is on regular bail vide order dated 26.08.2014 of the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar.
The trial is pending in the Ld. Court of the Special Judge, Amritsar.
- (b) FIR No. 138 dated 05.07.2017 Under section 15, 18, 21 and 22 NDPS Act;
(Date of Arrest 24.09.2017)
(Present Status: Petitioner was declared innocent during investigation)

- (c) *FIR No. 209 dated 09.10.2018 under section 18 NDPS Act PS Jandiala.
(Date of Arrest: 09.10.2018)
(Present Status: Petitioner is released on regular bail. The trial pending in the court of learned Special Judge, Amritsar.*
- (d) *FIR No. 251 dated 24.08.2021 under section 21 NDPS Act. The Petitioner was nominated vide DDR No. 20 Dated 2608-2021.
(Date of Arrest: 19.08.2022)
(Present Status: Petitioner is released on regular bail. The Trial pending in the court of Ld. Special Judge, Amritsar.)*
- (e) *FIR No. 154 dated 27.06.2023 under section 21 and 29 NDPS Act registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar (Rural).
(Date of Arrest: 27.06.2023)
(Present Status: Petitioner is released on regular bail. The Trial pending in the court of Ld. Special Judge, Amritsar.)”*

He further submits that the present petitioner was arrested in the above-said cases, however, he has been ordered to be released on bail and at present he is on bail. Learned State counsel further submits that the present petitioner is a habitual offender and he is involved in 05 other FIRs and he has filed the present petition only to pressurize the police illegally.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
