The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.156 dated 19.08.2021, under Sections 120-B, 34,406,420,467,468,471 of IPC, registered at Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
