The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.0168 dated 02.09.2022 registered under Section 420 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and as per compromise the petitioner is to make payment of Rs.3,20,000/- in total to the complainant out of which amount of Rs.1,00,000/- was paid on the last date of hearing to the complainant in the Court and today demand draft of Rs.1,10,000/- has been handed over to the counsel for the complainant and copy of the same is placed on record, while the balance amount of Rs.1,10,000/- will be paid to the complainant at the time when compromise quashing petition filed by the petitioner will be allowed by this Court.

3. Counsel appearing on behalf of complainant has not disputed the aforesaid statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and has

admitted the factum of compromise which has been effected between the parties.

4. The State counsel submits that the present petition could be disposed of in the light of the aforesaid statement made by the counsel for the parties.

5. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is to abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 Cr.P.C. and should join the investigation as and when called to do so by the police officials.
