1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of writ of certiorari for quashing or setting aside the notice dated 20.04.2023 (Annexure P-1), notice dated 17.05.2023 (Annexure P-3), notice dated 24.05.2023 (Annexure P-4), office order dated 18.07.2023 (Annexure P-7) and any other order arising out of the office order dated 18.07.2023 (Annexure P-7).

2. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 has submitted that apart from other issues, even a bond (Annexure P-10) has been executed by the petitioner, in which, it has been stated by the petitioners that the petitioners and the surety shall furnish Bank guarantee

amounting to Rs.10,00,000/- in favour of the Dean of the ESIC Institution in lieu of the total amount and the said bond is dated 19.02.2022, prior to the filing of the present writ petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the above, he seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh petition after giving full and better particulars.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.

5. In case any such petition is filed by the petitioners, the same would be considered independently, in accordance with law.
