The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of permission to the petitioner to leave India and travel to Canada for a period of 06 months from 15.08.2024 to 15.02.2025 in order to meet his son-Navdeep Singh and daughter-Navjot Kaur.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the grant of bail, the petitioner has joined the investigation which is still pending. The petitioner wishes to travel Canada for a period of 06 months to meet his son and daughter who are residing there. Therefore, the permission be granted for the said purpose.

3. The learned counsel for the State submits that the investigation is still pending but shall be concluded within a period of 04 weeks from today.

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4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court once again after the report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. is presented.
