1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to allow him to join duty and release his consequential benefits on account of revocation of his suspension.

2. Mr. Sandeep Bhatia, Sr. Standing Counsel, at the outset, submits that the petitioner has remedy to approach the Central Administrative Tribunal whereas he has directly approached this Court.

3. Faced with this, Mr.I.S.Pabla, Advocate submits that the present petition may be transferred to Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh.
