

are liable to be directed to recalculate the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance being raised in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 14.03.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-2 and the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, if the same is decided by passing appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Satnampreet Singh, DAG Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that, the representation dated 14.03.2024 appended in Annexure P-2 will be decided by the competent authority by keeping in mind the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Court as well as instructions issued by the Government of Punjab dated 10.07.2024 within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
