1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents to transfer the investigation to higher police official and conduct fair and unbiased investigation in FIR No.207 dated 11.05.2022 under Section 6 of Protection of Children From Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Sections 363, 366-A, 376-D, 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Tauru, District Nuh (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Manju, submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court on 12.08.2024, an affidavit dated 27.08.2024 of Vijay Pratap Singh, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Nuh on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in the Registry, which is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. He further submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner, in the present petition, has been substantially redressed as two of accused, namely, Sabir and Naseem have been arrested and final report qua them has already been filed

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before the jurisdictional police authorities and two accused, namely, Munfed and Tofik have been found innocent during the investigation and only one accused Talim is yet to be arrested. As such, nothing survives in the present petition. Learned State counsel, on instructions further submits that in case, there is any apprehension to life and liberty of the petitioner, the jurisdictional police authorities will ensure her safety.

3. In view of the stand taken by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition may kindly be disposed of at this stage, as no further directions are required to be issued.
4. Disposed of accordingly.
