1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the son of the petitioner is married to respondent No.6; the relations between his son and respondent No.6 are strained. It is in the above background, the private respondents have been extending threats of dire consequences to the petitioner and have also not hesitated to extend threats over the telephone. It has been submitted that even though a representation (Annexure P-2) dated 10.07.2024 had been given to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, however, it had been in vain.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate

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directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into his representation dated 10.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the representation dated 10.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law.
