On 02.08.2024, on behalf of the appellant statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellant to accept Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect.

Learned counsel for the appellant has made a statement before this Forum that one of the LR's, namely Surender Kumar (husband) has also expired on 22.08.2022. Death certificate is placed on record. His name be deleted from the array of parties. There a

Accordingly, Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh only) in the name of the LR No.2-Pooja Kumari and LR No.3-Hitesh in equal share with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 26.09.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
